

TOILET TRAINING

Children enrolled at Christ the King Catholic Montessori School must be fully toilet trained. A fully toilet trained child can do the following:

1. Communicate to the teachers the needs to use the restroom.
2. Stop what he/she is doing to go and use the restroom.
3. Undress and dress without assistance.
4. Wipe him/herself after using the toilet.
5. Get on/off the toilet by him/herself.
6. Wash and dry hands.
7. Postpone use of toilet if the restroom is in use or if away from the restroom.
8. Awaken during rest time should they need to use the restroom.

Students in the Children's House must have an extra uniform left at school, including underwear and socks, in case of an accident. We do understand that young children will occasionally have toileting accidents. By definition, "accidents" are unusual incidents and should happen infrequently. In these instances, the children will need to have the ability to independently and successfully change their clothes and clean themselves. Parents will be notified if a child has a toileting accident. Persistent instances may conclude in suspension or expulsion.

1. If three or more accidents occur in one week, the parent will be notified with the understanding that if the issue isn't corrected by the end of the second week, the child will have to stay home at least one week until he/she is fully toilet trained. Tuition will not be pro-rated during this time. Parents should contact the principal to facilitate the child's return to school.
2. If multiple accidents occur in one day, the parents will be notified and will need to bring a change of clothes and/or pick up the child; if not corrected after three days, the child will need to stay home at least one week until he/she is fully toilet trained. Tuition will not be pro-rated during this time. Parents should contact the principal to facilitate the child's return to school.
